Andrew Wright is an author, illustrator, teacher trainer and storyteller. As an author he has published: *Creating Stories With Children*, Oxford University Press; *Five Minute Activities*, Cambridge University Press; *1000+ Pictures for Teachers to Copy*, Longman Pearson. As a teacher trainer he has worked with teachers in thirty countries and as a story teller he has worked with approximately 50,000 students in the last fifteen years. Andrew's special interest in the last fifteen years has been in the role of stories in language teaching. In schools, world wide, he tells stories, helps students to make stories, helps students to make books and to create shadow theatre productions and he helps students to write stories and to write poetry. He feels very much that his focus has always been on practical activities in the classroom but based on a sound theoretical framework.

Andrew lives in Hungary where he is managing director, together with his wife, Julia Dudas of the International Languages Institute in Godollo. Andrew and Julia have two young daughters, Timea and Alexandra.
